

Funding Statistics




More than 40,000 families are enrolled in PA Head Start Programs

PHSA CORPORATE PARTNERSHIP LEVELS FAQ: Corporate Partnership

How do I become a Partner?

Complete and submit an **application** found on our **website**. Laura Imschweiler will respond to each applicant to confirm partnership.



What is the cost of each partnership level?

PREMIERE (Exclusive)	\$5,000
CHAMPION (Limited)	\$3,500
LEADER	\$2,500
SUPPORTER	\$1,500

What is the duration of a partnership?

A corporate partnership will be an **annual commitment**, concluding 365 days from the date that the partnership begins. Applications will be accepted January 1 through February 28 of each year.



A' LA CARTE CONFERENCE AND A' LA CARTE EVENTS What is the difference between the two?

A'la carte **conference items** are offered only during our PHSA Annual Spring Conference while a'la carte **event items** are offered throughout the year.

PRE-CONFERENCE SPONSOR

What is the cost and why is this exclusive?

Cost: \$1,200

Our pre-conference is an event that occurs the day before our annual conference begins. This event hosts attendees from the Office of Head Start Region III, in addition to our PA members. Be the exclusive vendor to welcome attendees, provide a brief presentation, and sponsor the lunch. *Limited to one sponsor*.

Cost: \$250

ADMINISTRATOR AND LEADER MEETING SPONSOR

What is the cost and why is this exclusive?

Cost: \$1,000

MEMBERSHIP MEETING SPONSOR

What is an informational webinar and how much?

Cost: \$500
